



STORAGE OF STUDENT WORK

Developing student skills in the use of ICT is part of the national Digital Education Revolution. Students at Adelaide High School are required to produce a range of assessment materials using ICT and the safe storage of these assessment tasks is important, particularly as students enter the senior years of schooling.

To ensure students develop safe and appropriate habits to save and store their work, we ask that students save their work on a USB or CDROM and on the hard drive of a family computer at home.

Students will not be able to store information on school laptops or the laptops purchased through the school Laptop Program, as work may be lost if the computer requires reconfiguration by the school's IT technicians. Reconfiguration will occur if there is a problem with the computer and in this process data stored on the computer will not be able to be retrieved.

Parents / carers are asked to ensure students have a USB or other storage device to save work, and that they are encouraged to regularly back up their work on a home computer.
